School events

We have had a busy few weeks, even though this has been a short half term! We had Rock Kidz just before the Easter holidays and were again praised for our amazing behaviour. Year 6 have completed their SATs and tried so hard. We are incredibly proud of them.

School dinners

Remember to book your child's meal (even if they are having packed lunch) on School Hub before they return on Tuesday 3rd June. Also remember to please cancel any meals booked in advance if your child is ill, as otherwise you (or school if they are Free school meals) will be charged for them.

Now would be a good time to apply for free school meals if you don't already receive them as you will receive vouchers over the summer holidays. These vouchers are only for people who have applied, so if your child is in Key Stage 1 and has school dinners they will not receive the vouchers automatically. We do ask all parents who are eligible to apply, regardless of which year they are in, and even if their child has packed lunch as school receives extra funding which we can spend on supporting your children. Children in Year 2 especially will need to apply as otherwise they will not get free meals in Year 3. If you feel that you may qualify for this the link is below

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
Uniform

As we approach the end of the academic year I would ask all parents to ensure their children are in school whenever possible and consider the impact attendance has on your child's progress. Only having 90% attendance for the year means your child has missed 4 weeks of school overall. That's almost a whole month of learning!
